On March 22, 2012, the General Government/Local Assistance Subcommittee completed its work. We are pleased to present this report, which provides detail on all the budget matters agreed to by the subcommittee.


The Subcommittee has reached agreement on spending and on various Article VII proposals for agencies under the jurisdiction of this subcommittee as follows:

- Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control
- Division of Audit and Control
- Division of Budget
- State Board of Elections
- Executive Chamber
- Joint Commission on Public Ethics
- Department of Financial Services – Banking and Insurance
- Office of General Services
- Office of Inspector General
- Department of State – Consumer Affairs
- Department of Taxation and Finance – Office of Real Property Services
- Division of Tax Appeals
- Office for Technology

The Subcommittee has sent the final decision for any additional aid to localities to the General Conference Committee. In addition, the Subcommittee has sent the General Conference Committee final decision on other Article VII proposals.

The Subcommittee advanced a request to the General Conference Committee that \$1.249 million of the General Fund is allocated as follows:

- \$505,000 for the Public Utility Law Project (PULP);
- \$65,000 for construction of a security portal at the State Street entrance to the Legislative Office Building;
- \$479,000 for membership dues for various public policy and research organizations;
- \$200,000 for rejection of an Article VII proposal related to process service on business entities and elimination of the classification system for not-for-profit corporations.
