Keeping more money in your pocket

You work hard for your money, that's why Assemblyman Angelo Santabarbara fought to extend the lowest tax rate for middle-class families in 60 years and is working to keep programs like STAR free from fraud.

Homeowners currently receiving a Basic STAR exemption must register to receive the exemption in 2014 and subsequent years.

Taking a few minutes to register your Basic STAR exemption can help save New Yorkers over \$50 million in fraudulent claims.

Focusing on education

Providing access to a quality education is key to a child's future success. With this in mind, Assemblyman Santabarbara supported this year's budget, which **increased state education funding for Berne-Knox-Westerlo Central School District by over \$850,000.**

Making New York more business friendly


Assemblyman Santabarbara is helping make New York more business friendly by lowering the cost of doing business to keep companies here and attract new businesses to the area.

Assemblyman Santabarbara is **reducing costs for businesses and cutting red tape.** He sponsored a new law that streamlines the relicensing process for chain food processing establishments, helping save time, money and resources (Ch. 260 of 2013).

To lower taxes on manufacturers so they can compete and grow, Assemblyman Santabarbara voted to reduce the current 3.25 percent tax rate on manufacturing companies to 2.4 percent by 2018.

By voting to **reduce energy taxes** – a move that will save utility customers \$500 million – Assemblyman Santabarbara is lowering energy costs for all.

Additionally, **Assemblyman Santabarbara helped create tax breaks for businesses that hire veterans.** This legislation will boost employment rates for veterans – one of the groups hit hardest by unemployment – and will save businesses money. It's our duty to take care of the veterans who honorably served our country.
