As we quickly approach another legislative session, we should reflect on this past year and look ahead to our legislative goals for 2020. As a general update, I am happy to report that I have secured over \$11 million in funding for schools in our district to make critical security and technology upgrades to keep our children safe. Much of this construction was completed over the summer in time for the start of the new school year.
