## Summer Youth Employment

There are a number of services out there for our youth. One of the services Assemblyman Ramos wants you to know about is New York State's Summer Youth Employment Program. Through the program, Suffolk County will receive over \$950,000 to provide job opportunities to teens looking for work over the summer season.

To be eligible for the program, participants must be between the ages 14 and 20, and their total family income must be below 200 percent of the federal poverty level. For example, the income for a family of three must be below \$39,060 a year. Assemblyman Ramos encourages all eligible youth to apply.

## Empleos de verano para jóvenes

Hay una serie de servicios disponibles para nuestros jóvenes. Uno de los servicios que el asambleísta Ramos quiere que usted conozca es el Programa de Empleos de Verano para Jóvenes del Estado de Nueva York. A través del programa, el condado de Suffolk recibirá más de \$950,000 para proveer oportunidades de empleo a los jóvenes que buscan trabajo durante la temporada de verano.

Para ser elegible para el programa, los participantes deben de tener entre 14 y 20 años, y su ingreso familiar total debe ser menos del 200 por ciento del nivel federal de pobreza. Por ejemplo, el ingreso de una familia de tres debe ser menos de \$39,060 al año. El asambleísta Ramos exhorta a todos los jóvenes elegibles a solicitar este programa.
