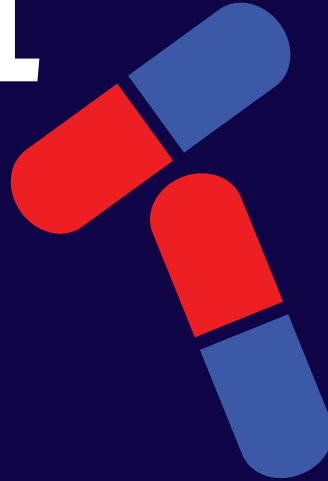

The Sheriff's Office Medical ID Cards program is free, open to seniors 50 years old and older, and no appointments are necessary. The Sheriff's Office Medical ID Cards will assist seniors or those with medical needs to keep all required medical information available on a small card with them at all times in case of emergency.

Get Rid Of Unused, Expired, Or Unwanted Medication by dropping them off inside the library for safe disposal by the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office. Liquid medications and sharps will not be accepted. No age requirement, people of all ages are encouraged to discard their unwanted medication.
