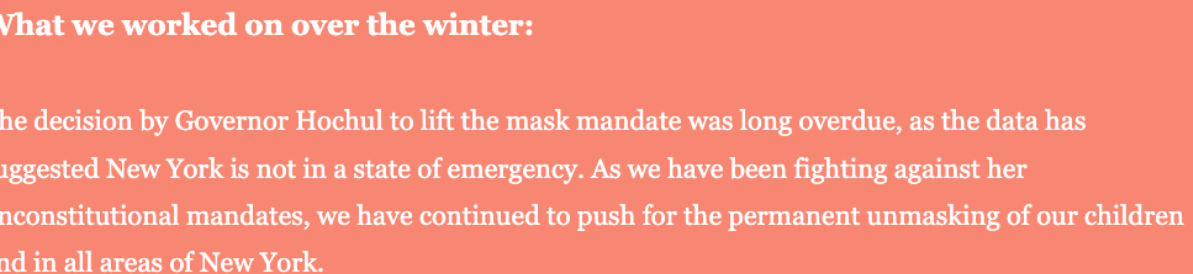


Dear Neighbor,

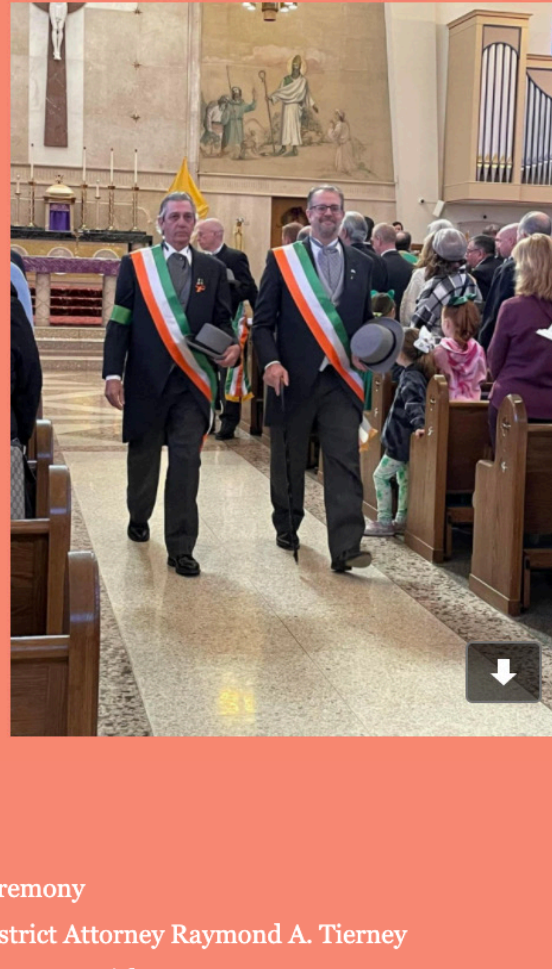

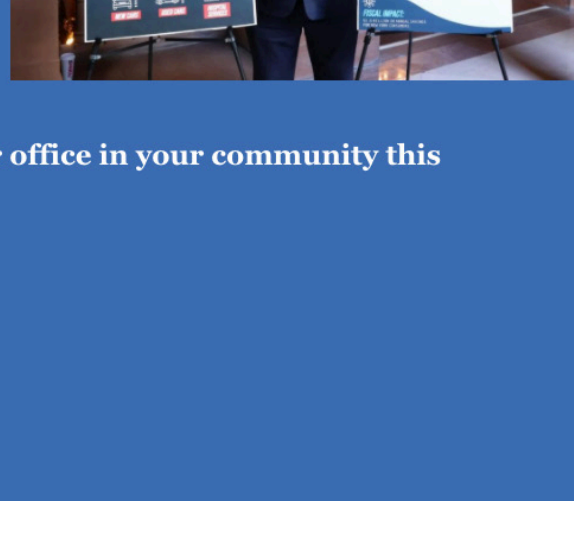
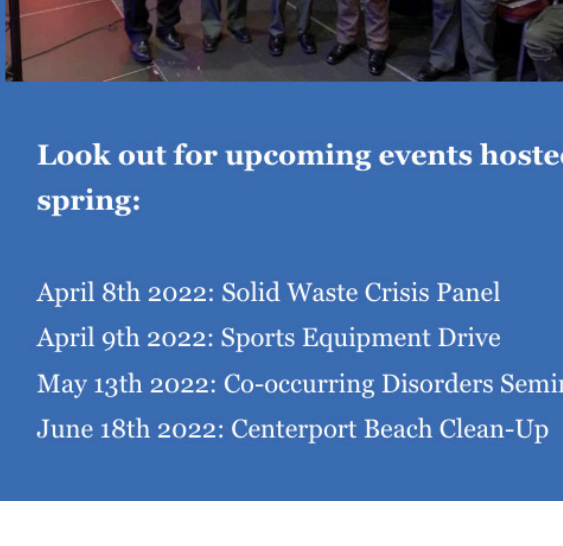
