Child Care & Affordability

As a father, Assemblyman Norber knows parents shouldn't have to choose between their jobs and quality care for their children. By investing in families and supporting providers, we can make child care more accessible and affordable for all.

My Plan to Support Long Island's Working Families

- More tax incentives for families & providers because Albany should be helping, not hurting, our families.
 - Child and Dependent Care Credit: Provides an average of \$345 to help cover care expenses for kids and dependents.¹
 - Empire State Child Credit: Delivers an average of \$480 per family to support raising children.²
 - Earned Income Tax Credit: Boosts working families with an average of \$1,301, aiding those juggling work and child care.³

Strengthening Early Childhood Education:

- Generate an additional \$30 million in state aid for⁴
 Universal Pre-K by increasing the reimbursement rate.
- Expand partnerships between schools and child care providers.⁴
- Streamline hiring for qualified UPK teachers.

Expanding Access:

- Support non-traditional child care hours (nights & weekends).⁵
- Allow in-home child care options for multiple families.
- Enable alternative child care models using waivers.⁶
