MY COLLEAGUES AND I IN THE MINORITY HAVE A PLAN TO FIX THE MIGRANT CRISIS

- Protect municipalities from "Right to Shelter" confusion by requiring local governing bodies in the state to opt-in to accepting migrants from other jurisdictions (A.8034).
- Ensure funding is not used to shelter migrants in schools, daycare centers or community organization buildings (A.8013).
- Require the comptroller to examine and audit state and federal funds received and appropriated for humanitarian aid in NYC or any municipality (A.7508).
- End New York's status as an immigration sanctuary until proper planning is discussed.
- Adopt a resolution calling on the federal government to provide financial assistance and properly address the border crisis it created.
- Require the state to register all migrants to assist with background checks and monitor refugees seeking asylum (A.7319-A).

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT:

New York's escalating migrant crisis has now resulted in a full humanitarian and economic crisis. More than 130,600 migrants flooded New York within the past year.³ In response, Albany has earmarked \$1.5 billion in state taxpayer money for New York City to spend on the migrant crisis.⁴ According to the New York City mayor's projections, these costs are expected to surpass \$12 billion by 2025!³ As your Assemblyman, I believe New York State should end its sanctuary status.
