

Assemblywoman Solages Releases 2019 Constituent Questionnaire Survey Results



2019 Constituent Questionnaire Questions:


1. Controlled Safe injection sites have been proposed as a method of preventing deaths from overdoses. Would you support safe injection sites that allow supervised drug uses?

63% Oppose




2. Several States have legalized Physician-assisted dying. Do you support the legalization of Physician-assisted suicide?

43% Support





38% Oppose




4. Would you support a ban on the sale of flavored e-cigarettes?

27% Oppose




5. Do you support the full legalization of marijuana in NY?

59% Support




6. If marijuana was legalized for recreational use, would you be supportive of the expungement of certain marijuana drug charges from criminal records?

39% Oppose




7. Would you support allowing sports gambling/betting in NYS?

50% Oppose




8. Do you support legislation that would authorize Nassau County to install speed cameras in school zones?

49% Oppose




9. Would you support legislation to allow alcohol to be sold in movie theaters?

77% Oppose




10. Early voting

29% Oppose




11. Allow schools to opt-out of their role as a polling place.


12. Should Election Day be made a state holiday?

44% Oppose




13. Would you allow school security officers to carry a firearm if the officer is a former law enforcement officer, has met enhanced training requirements, and is authorized by the local school board?
