Assembly Member Clyde Vanel is making sure *every voice is heard*

To strengthen our democracy, the Assembly passed legislation to:

- ✓ Establish early voting, which would take place during a nine-day period before elections (Ch. 6 of 2019)
- ✓ Ensure voter registration is automatically transferred to your new county when you move (Ch. 3 of 2019)
- ✓ Allow everyone to vote by absentee ballot (A.778)
- ✓ Permit 16- and 17-year-olds to pre-register to vote (Ch. 2 of 2019)
- ✓ Close the LLC loophole to stop special interests from making nearly unlimited campaign contributions (Ch. 4 of 2019)
- ✓ Combine the state and federal primary days (Ch. 5 of 2019)

This year's state budget:

- Provides \$10 million to help localities implement early voting
- Provides \$14.7 million for counties to purchase electronic poll books and on-demand ballot printers
- Requires polling places be open on primary day from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.
