**Juneteenth**, marks the day in 1865 that troops arrived in Texas and freed enslaved people. The troops' arrival came a full two and a half years after the signing of the **Emancipation Proclamation**, which declared that as of January 1, 1863, all enslaved people in the states currently engaged in rebellion against the Union "shall be then, thenceforward, and forever **free**."<sup>[1]</sup>.

This week, Congress decreed Juneteenth, **June 19th**, a national, **federal holiday**. On this day, let us honor our ancestors and celebrate their liberation.
