Dear Friends and Neighbors,

All of us were deeply horrified to learn of the devastating mass shooting in Brooklyn's Sunset Park on Tuesday. Our hearts and prayers go out to the injured victims, families and friends impacted so viciously.

Governor Hochul accepted the resignation of Brian Benjamin as New York State Lieutenant Governor following his indictment on federal corruption charges. We must have absolute confidence in the integrity of all those entrusted with the honor of public service in elected office.

The 2022-23 state budget I helped craft gives New Yorkers' middle-class tax cuts, an extra child tax credit and Earned Income Tax Credit payment, and \$2.2 billion in property tax relief checks.

The final budget provides a \$250 million fund to help with utility arrears for those who had higher energy bills this past winter and furthers our investment in safe, affordable housing.

I am proud to announce the inclusion of our bill language in the budget to provide equitable access to highly specialized cancer care at National Cancer Institute (NCI) designated facilities. With the adoption of the budget we have expanded coverage for individuals and small groups, including Medicaid-managed care plans and other qualified health plans.

2022-23 New York State Budget Highlights

Education and Transportation

Our struggling transportation system provides \$6.17 billion for Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) transit assistance for subways, buses, bridges, and tunnels, increasing by \$993 million – or 19.2%.

This year's budget increases school aid by \$2.1 billion over last year's budget. In addition, we fought and won a \$1.5 billion increase in Foundation Aid, delivering on the commitment we made last year to fully fund Foundation Aid within three years.

Housing

We provided \$4.5 billion for a new five-year affordable housing capital plan and \$1 billion for Affordable Rental Housing. Folks needing help with rent payments will benefit from a \$1.1 billion for the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) and Landlord Rental Assistance Program (LRAP). In addition, the New York City Housing Authority is receiving \$350 million in capital funding for construction and desperately needed repairs.

Environment

The \$4.2 billion Environmental Bond Act of 2022 will be on the ballot for voter approval in November. Projects include:

- Climate mitigation.
- Restoration and flood risk reduction.
- Water quality projects and measures to increase open space conservation and recreation facilities.

Criminal Justice

We've made changes to speedy trial requirements to reinforce the intent of the original law. While there are specified deadlines for disclosing discovery, we know that there are delays in providing materials that should not be the sole basis for dismissing a case.

Includes \$40 million for district attorneys' offices for additional staff, expanded storage capabilities, and new and updated technology to help prosecutors handle increased discovery requirements.

Health

More than \$1.8 billion in new funding will go to Medicaid, public health programs, and public hospitals. In addition, we are expanding health care coverage for undocumented immigrants for one year of postpartum coverage following the end of pregnancy and providing Medicaid coverage for undocumented seniors aged 65 and older.

Children's mental health and the first 988 Suicide and Behavioral Health Crisis Hotline support those experiencing a mental health or substance use disorder crisis.

Small businesses

We're providing \$250 million to create a refundable tax credit for small business COVID-19-related expenses, with a minimum credit of \$1,000 per business; other innovative programs will provide a \$100 million tax cut for New York small businesses.

Higher Education

SUNY and CUNY will get additional operating support, expanded tuition assistance covering part-time students, more money for Excelsior scholarships, full-time faculty, and nursing programs. In addition, Mote than \$335 million will go towards construction and repairs on SUNY and CUNY campuses. Expanded child care on campuses is also funded and the 17.5 hour a week work requirement.
