On November 22, Speaker Heastie gave out free holiday food in conjunction with FreshDirect, City Harvest, Slick Rick & Victory Patch Foundation, Bronx Borough President Ruben Diaz Jr., Congressman Jamaal Bowman, Councilman Kevin Riley and Senator Jamaal Bailey. The event was a tremendous success enjoyed by everyone in attendance. Residents were able to enjoy the new YMCA facility and have conversations with Bronx community leaders. Five hundred turkeys with fixings, groceries as well as hot meals were distributed to families in the 83rd Assembly District.

## **Resurfacing Roads in the Edenwald Neighborhood**

Speaker Heastie, in conjunction with NYC DOT, has been able to secure a commitment for the city to resurface the areas surrounding Edenwald Houses. The roads surrounding the Edenwald Houses have fallen into disrepair and are now scheduled to get much-needed repairs. The resurfacing is for Edenwald Avenue between Baychester Avenue and Wilder Avenue.

#### Safety Improvements coming along White Plains Road from East 214th St. to East 226th St.:

- Install curbside parking protected bike lane on northbound White Plains Road between East 214th St. and East 226th St. and southbound White Plains Road between East 216th St. and East 226th St.
- Install painted pedestrian islands on White Plains Road between East 215th St. and East 226th St.
- Continue installation of new traffic signal at East 215th St.
- Reduce northbound White Plains Road to one lane between East 214th St. and East 216th St.
- Update curb regulations and install commercial loading zones at select locations

Implementation began in late October 2021.

#### NYC DOT will be installing a bicycle network expansion and greenway connection project on East 233rd Street, Webster Avenue and Bronx Boulevard. The project will include:

- Protected bike lanes on Webster Avenue between Nereid Avenue and East 233rd St., and East 233rd St. between Webster Avenue and Bronx Boulevard
- Bus improvements with boarding islands on Webster Avenue and East 233rd St.
- Pedestrian improvements with painted pedestrian spaces, a new crosswalk and an actuated pedestrian signal with signal timing improvements at East 233rd St. and Bronx Boulevard

This project was implemented in the fall of 2021.

#### Safety improvements coming to Webster Ave. from East 240th St. to East 233rd St., and East 233rd St. at Webster Avenue and Bronx Boulevard:

- Install parking protected bike lanes on Webster Avenue between East 240th St. and East 233rd St.
- Install delineator protected bike lanes on East 233rd St. between Webster Avenue and Bronx Boulevard
- Install new pedestrian crosswalk at East 233rd St. and **Bronx Boulevard**
- Change direction of travel to one-way southbound on Bronx Boulevard from East 233rd St. to Bronx River Parkway on ramp
- Update travel direction to two-way on Bronx Boulevard between Bronx River Parkway and East 229th St.
- Build concrete bus boarding islands on Webster Avenue at East 240 St., East 235 St. and Bronx River Parkway
- Install bus boarder with bike lane access on East 233rd St. Implementation began in early October.

# \$43 Million Capital Improvements for Haffen Park

Speaker Heastie, Councilman Riley and Mayor de Blasio announced that the city is allocating \$43 million for improvements for Haffen Park in the Northeast Bronx. Speaker Heastie grew up playing in the park and has worked with city officials to solicit suggestions on improvements for residents of the Northeast Bronx.

As a result of this outreach, the pool will receive a full reconstruction with an estimated cost of \$5-10 million. Design for the project began in August 2021 and the reconstruction is projected to be completed in October 2022.

Additionally, the Haffen Park Playground and Landscape will get a full renovation. This project will reconstruct the playground and landscape, including pavement, water and drainage systems, park lighting and plantings. Finally, the project will construct an adult fitness area at Haffen Park. Design for the project began in May 2021 and the full renovations/construction is estimated to take 12 to 18 months.

"Myself, Councilman Kevin Riley and Senator Jamaal Bailey are committed to improving all the parks in our community," said Speaker Heastie.
