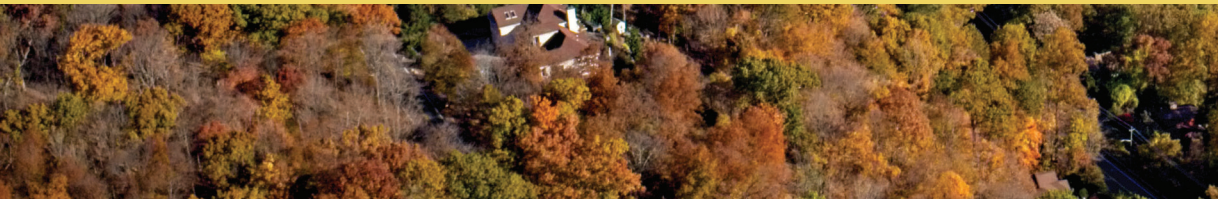

Assemblyman Wieder's Bill to Help Preserve Orangetown Community Spaces Signed Into Law

Assemblyman Wieder heard from Orangetown's local government and worked to pass the **Community Preservation Fund** legislation that is now law (Ch.518 of 2025)

Creates a five-year **Orangetown Community Preservation Project Plan**, promoting responsible, locally proposed development projects while preserving land and recreational areas.

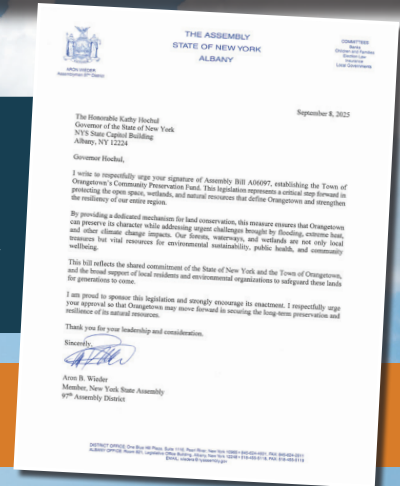
Allows Orangetown to establish a **Community Preservation Fund**, overseen by a non-compensated board with members having proven preservation experience.

Funded through a surcharge, not to exceed three-fourths of 1%, on the transfer of real property in the town.



Orangetown Supervisor Teresa Kenny said, "Orangetown's Community Preservation Fund will help protect our local landscapes and natural resources for future generations to enjoy. I want to thank Assemblyman Wieder for his leadership and partnership on this effort."
