Assemblyman Aron Wieder is helping secure crucial investments in Ramapo



Wieder helped secure funding to strengthen our public services and save local taxpayer money:

- ✓ **\$100,000** to purchase a modern brine-making machine (*CRE25 - 2025 Capital Funding*)
- ✓ **\$50,000** to both the Village of Kaser's bus service and the Village of New Square's shuttle (*Department of State - 2025 Budget*)
- ✓ **\$10,000** to support the vital food security assistance nonprofit Tomchei Shabbos (*Office of Children and Family Services - 2025 Budget*)



Assemblyman Wieder discussed critical upgrades to aging local infrastructure and legislation to support the work with Ramapo Town Supervisor Michael Specht, Chief of Staff Mona Montal and Ramapo Police Chief Danny Hyman.
