Accomplishments

★ I helped ensure cancer patients have the tools they need to fight their battle through Biomarker Testing (*Chapter 754 of the Laws of New York State 2023*)

★ I advocated for our children in need to receive free breakfast and lunch in school.^{1,2} It was ultimately included in the 2023-24 State Budget last year, which is great news for families.³

★ I fought to create a Fiscal Cliff Task Force that would encourage people on public assistance to get back to work through tools and incentives (*A.7424-A*)

★ I advocated for grant money for the Walden VFW infrastructure project and Goshen EMS to fund advanced life support services.⁴ Each organization received a \$75,000 grant, which was provided for in the 2023-24 State Budget last year.⁵

Goals

★ Address the issue of youth flight by connecting them with various industries to provide career paths while working with local community colleges (*A.6496*)

★ Help combat overdose deaths by helping our medical personnel and first responders identify drugs related to overdoses (*A.7746*)

★ Ensure jobs for local laborers by requiring construction jobs that utilize certain state benefits to hire locally (*A.7747*)

★ Declare EMS an essential service and provide local EMS agencies with the resources they need to save lives (*A.3392-B*)
