Re: A11560 / S10642 – One-Year Data Center Moratorium

Dear Governor Hochul:

I respectfully urge you to sign **A11560/S10642**, establishing a one-year moratorium on new data centers in New York State.

Over the past several months, I have heard from hundreds of constituents through emails, public hearings, town board meetings, rallies, and countless conversations. Their message has been clear: pause the rapid expansion of data centers until we fully understand their impacts on our communities, infrastructure, electric grid, environment, and quality of life.

That message was reinforced again last night, as residents packed the East Fishkill Town Board meeting to advocate for a local data center moratorium.

I was proud to serve as the **sole Republican co-sponsor** of this legislation because I believe the voices of the people we represent should always come before partisan politics. As I have said throughout this process, **the will of my community far supersedes partisan politics.**

This temporary pause is a responsible step that gives New York the opportunity to evaluate the long-term impacts of these facilities before additional projects move forward. I respectfully ask that you stand with the residents who have spoken so clearly and sign **A11560/S10642** into law.
