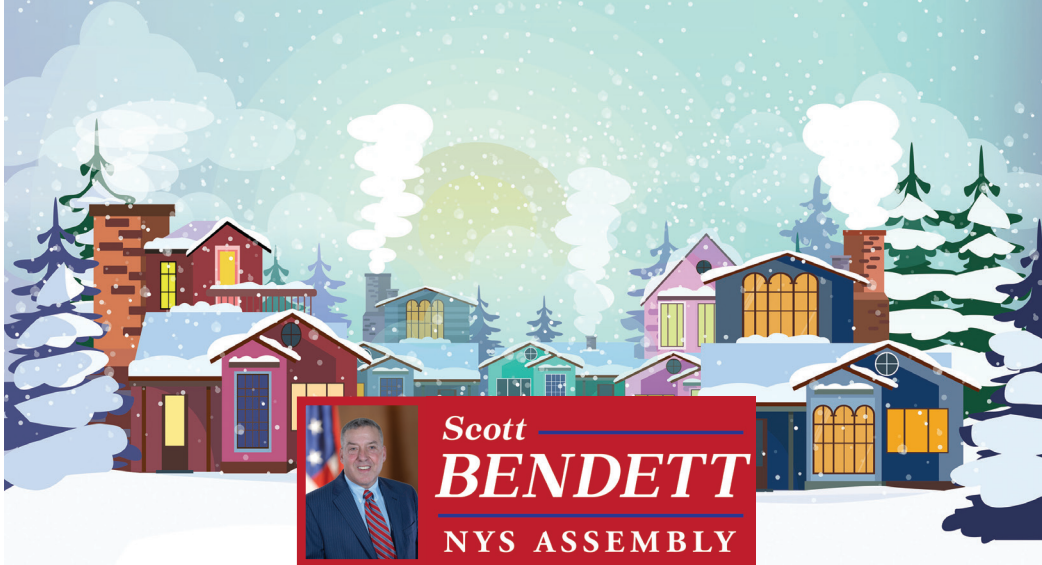

According to the New York State Climate Action Council Final Scoping Plan from 2022, the Climate Action Council aimed to prevent new gas service to existing buildings in 2025. However, forcing a switch to all-electric could lead to:

Longer blackouts
Fewer energy choices
More money out of our pockets¹

When snowstorms hit, New York households can lose electricity for days. While temperatures drop into the negatives, gas stoves and gas heating help us keep food on the table and our loved ones warm.

To ensure families continue to have access to natural gas fixtures for home heating and cooking, I voted **against** Bill A.3006-C, which would prohibit the installation of gas service equipment, including gas stoves, in some new buildings in 2026.
