New York's first 'Autism Action Plan' becomes a reality!

Last year, we were successful in getting a critical piece of **Autism Action NY** passed into law (Ch. 469 of 2016). The measure creates the state's first **Autism Spectrum Disorder Advisory Board** to develop, implement and update a statewide **Autism Action Plan**, incorporates new information as it becomes available and creates a central location for available services.
