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

Funding for the Autism Society of the Greater Capital Region

New funding for programs like College Success and Gig Works in this year's state budget provide high school graduates and adults with autism more educational and employment opportunities.

Expanding the mission of NY's Autism Advisory Board

New legislation will help the state Autism Spectrum Disorders Advisory Board promote early detection of autism, map and track cases, provide counseling and referral services and create public awareness in our community.
