Protecting those who protect us

- Making it an aggravated harassment crime to throw bodily fluids at police officers (A.1427).
- Establishing a felony for falsely reporting incidents to prompt a large police response (A.2977).
- Providing an income tax credit for retired, disabled police officers (A.3247).
- Expanding employment opportunities for retired police officers as special security officers for school districts (A.4554).

Supporting those who sacrifice their lives

- Giving up to a \$1,200 tax credit to volunteer firefighters and ambulance corps members in good standing (A.185).
- Addressing concerns in volunteer firefighter and ambulance services by creating special ambulance service districts and mandating a report on staffing concerns (A.2812).
- Extending the percentage of nonresident volunteer members in a village fire company (A.2116).
