- More than 103,000 Americans, including nearly 8,000 New Yorkers, are currently on the national organ transplant waiting list.
- Every 8 minutes, another person is added to the national transplant waiting list.
- ▼ In 2024, 377 New Yorkers died because the organs they needed to save their lives were not donated in time.
- ▼ I,009 New Yorkers have been waiting more than five years for an organ transplant.
