**In addition to more funding for treatment, I support:**

- ❖ Providing opioid antidotes to first responders.
- ❖ Educating our youth on the dangers of drug and substance abuse.
- ❖ Enacting Laree's Law, which would allow law enforcement to charge a drug dealer with homicide if the drugs they sold cause a death. This bill also helps law enforcement target mid- to high-level drug dealers. (**A.3398**)
- ❖ Implementing harsher penalties for selling drugs like heroin and opioids. (**A.3474**) (**A.3202**)
