

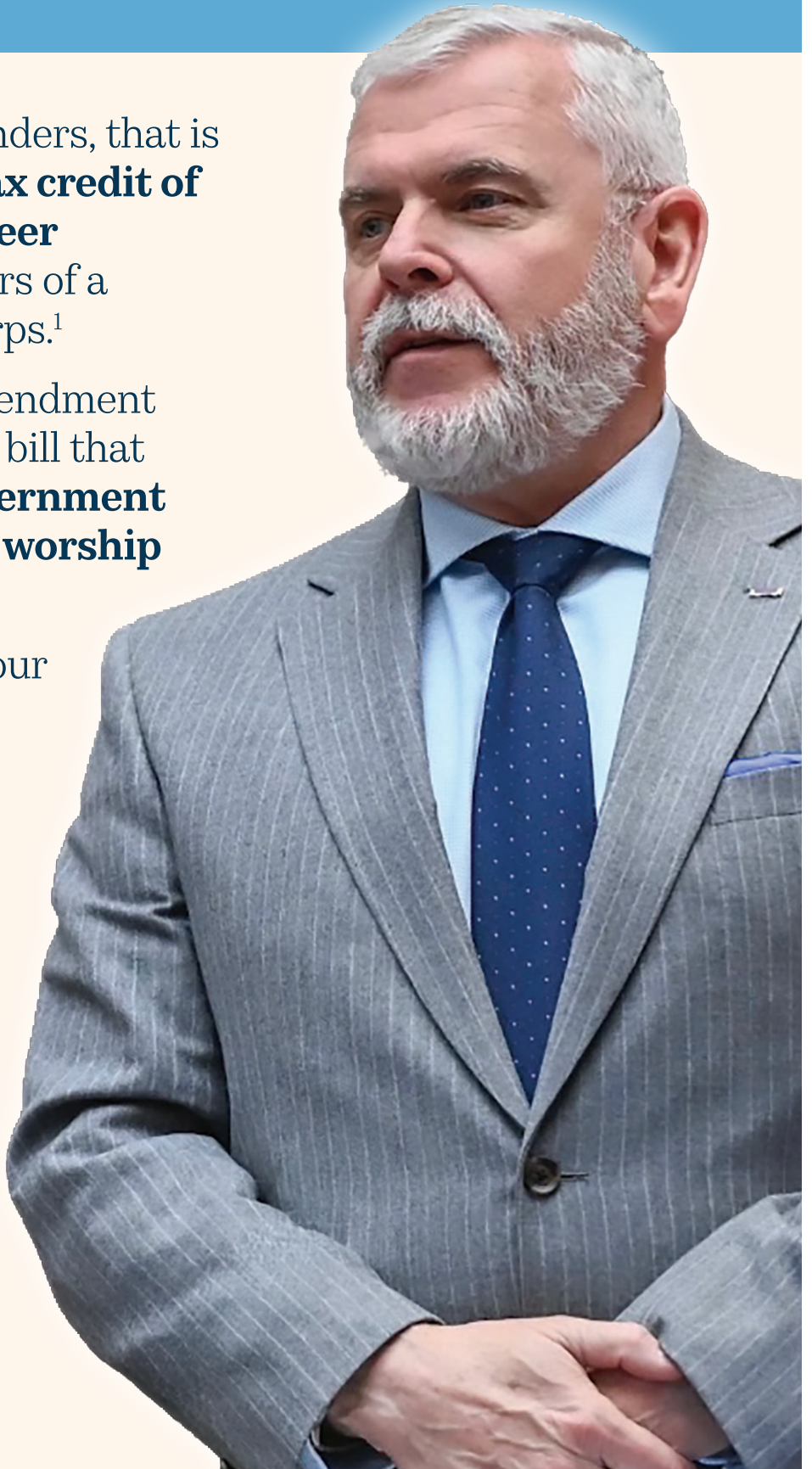
# LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

I support our first responders, that is why I have proposed a **tax credit of up to \$2,500 for volunteer firefighters** and members of a volunteer ambulance corps.<sup>1</sup>

To protect your First Amendment rights, I have proposed a bill that **would prohibit the government from closing houses of worship** during an emergency.<sup>2</sup>

I am working to protect our children by supporting a bill that would **prohibit sex offenders from using any state- or municipality-owned park.**<sup>3</sup>

I back the blue, that is why I am proposing that anyone who murders a police officer is **held behind bars for life** with no chance of parole.<sup>4</sup>

5. In honor of National Vietnam War Veterans Day, I visited American Legion Post 189 to say “thank you” and “welcome home” to Vietnam veterans.

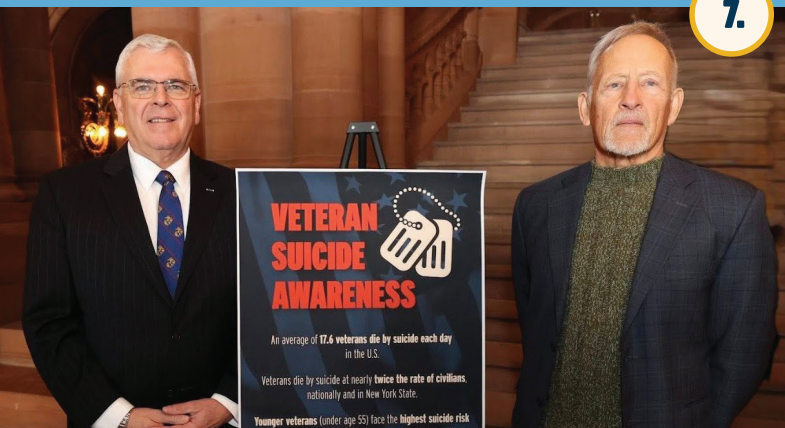


6. As a pet owner myself, I attended the Luszi's Legacy fundraiser to help raise money to help other pet owners afford proper, professional care for their pets.
