Honoring fallen officers by supporting the Division of Criminal Justice Services in adding the names of New York State peace officers slain in the line of duty to the Police Officers Memorial (A.2992).

**Keeping local law enforcement safe** by supporting policies that expedite the application process for police officers applying for a firearms license throughout New York State (A.4859).
