- ◆ **Protect Farmland for Future Generations**
Connects the next generation of farmers with farmland access and transfer assistance.²
- ◆ **Fight for Rural Communities**
Creates a Rural Equity Assistance Program to help small towns and rural communities identify grants, secure funding and access technical assistance for economic development projects.³
- ◆ **Protect Farmers from Rising Energy Costs**
Reviews energy policies to ensure reliable and affordable power for farmers and other power consumers.⁴
