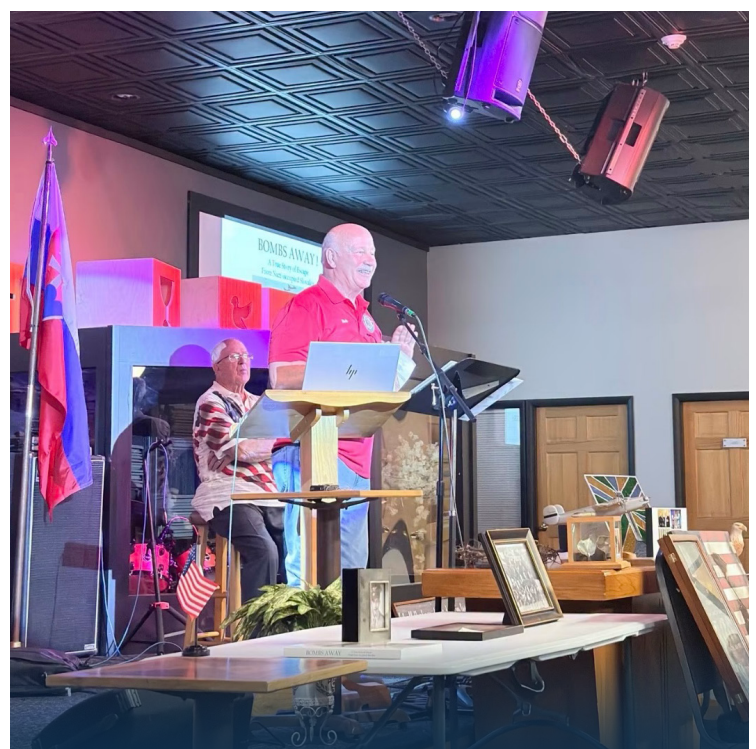
Foodlink Curbside Market
