JOSH'S PUBLIC SAFETY PLAN

As crime is surging in our region¹, some elected officials are proposing to close more prisons² and defund law enforcement³. We can't let this be the new normal for the Empire State. That's why Josh wants to bolster public safety and better protect and support law enforcement and first responders.

JOSH'S PLAN:

- Discourages reckless behavior by making it a violent felony to fire a gun into a crowded space, regardless of the outcome (A.4259).
- Provides discretion to judges so they can consider whether or not an offender* is a public safety risk when determining pre-trial release (A.4964).
- Protects the well-being of our courageous men and women in uniform by increasing the penalties for menacing a police officer or peace officer (A.6578).
- Eliminates a loophole which currently allows inmates to get away with some assaults involving bodily fluids against corrections officers (A.2256).
- Strengthens laws protecting police and first responders by increasing penalties against individuals who attack them on the job (A.6575).
