

Now that the 2023 Legislative Session has come to a close, it's been an honor to serve as our community's voice in Albany for another year. Western New York is a special place to live, and I will continue to use my voice to fight for the issues that matter most to our community.

This session I supported proposals that:

- Would increase protection for victims of domestic abuse through the passage of "Melanie's Law" to expand orders of protection to close family members (A.6026).
- Designated a portion of State Route 63 as the "SP4 George Harold Fry Memorial Highway" (A.7415).
- Would increase access to college education for veterans at SUNY schools (A.1474).
- S Increased efficiency in the justice system by allowing defendants to appear electronically in Orleans County (A.5288).
