High inflation hurts workers the most. To help ease the financial strain on local families, Assemblyman Burke passed a state budget that provides:

- **\$2.2 billion** of property tax rebate checks for households that are eligible for School Tax Relief (STAR) and earn \$250,000 or less a year
- an acceleration of the phase-in of middle-class tax cuts so they are fully effective in 2023 instead of 2025, saving taxpayers **\$777 million** over the next two years
- \$475 million for an additional Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit payment
- **\$250 million** to help New Yorkers catch up on utility bills
