## **Assemblymember Wallace** on how the state budget supports Western New Yorkers and their families

- **Cuts middle-class income tax rates** from 6.45 percent to 5.5 percent for households earning between \$40,000 and \$150,000
- **Invests \$538 million in CHIPs and the Marchiselli program**, as well as additional investments in PAVE-NY, all which repair local roads and bridges
- **Provides vital funding** to assist municipalities with extreme weather recovery
- **Promotes economic development initiatives** in Western New York
- **Supports families by investing \$80 million** in child care initiatives
- **Funds community programs** that support veterans and their families
