Assemblymember Wallace on how the state budget supports Western New Yorkers and their families

- **Ensures municipalities receive their full amount of AIM funding** so that local governments can maintain essential services
- **Increases state aid to local schools** by \$1 billion statewide
- **Invests \$500 million more in the Clean Water Infrastructure Act** to improve water quality and repair aging infrastructure
- **Expands access to affordable child care by allocating \$832 million to assist working families** and provides employer incentives to assist employees with child care expenses
- **Invests \$438 million in CHIPs funding** to assist municipalities in repairing local roads and bridges
- **Provides vital funding to community colleges** to ensure affordable access to higher education and vocational training
