GREEN LIGHT BILL:

Allows unlawful persons to obtain driver's licenses and other government identification. County clerks across the state have expressed concerns over their ability to verify the authenticity of foreign documents, and some have even sued the state. Not only did I vote against the bill because of these concerns, but I also am worried that this could give non-citizens the ability to vote.

DREAM ACT:

X I VOTED "NO"

Uses your tax dollars to pay for the college tuition of undocumented immigrants and their children. Here in Western New York, too many of our college-bound students and recent graduates have to move out of state in order to pursue lower tax climates where they can truly succeed. Instead of making college more affordable, or lowering taxes so graduates can afford to stay here, Albany chose instead to prioritize this measure. I voted no, and will continue working to protect your tax dollars.

LICENSE PLATE FEES:

✓ FOUGHT GOVERNOR AND DELIVERED

When the governor proposed mandating all New Yorkers to pay additional fees for new, unnecessary license plates, I said "NO WAY." Working together with local officials and the public who saw this as nothing more than a money grab, we succeeded in convincing the governor to change his mind.
