

## Clean Water, Safe Roads

All over New York, our highways, bridges, and water infrastructure are crumbling. That's why Assemblyman Morinello is fighting for:

- → \$100 million for both PAVE-NY and Bridge NY to ensure our families are safe traveling to and from school and work.¹
- Restoration of the \$65 million Extreme Winter Recovery Fund, helping our local municipalities and highway departments restore our roads after harsh winters.<sup>2</sup>
- → An increase in Consolidated Local Street and Highway Improvement Program funding of \$100 million, raising it to \$538.1 million.<sup>3</sup>
- → Continuation of the \$2.5 billion Clean Water Infrastructure Act, and an additional \$500 million this year to update drinking and wastewater infrastructure throughout New York.<sup>4</sup>
- → A companion for the CHIPS program, offering financial assistance to local governments for drinking, storm, and sewer water infrastructure, called the Water Infrastructure Investment Program (WIIPS).<sup>5</sup>
