What the 2018 Legislative Session Means for Your Family

Assemblyman David DiPietro fought for our Western New York values this legislative session.

Legislative Wins:

- ✓ Increased Foundation Aid by \$618 million for our schools. (A. 9504-D)
- ✓ \$96.6 million invested in Library Aid to help our struggling libraries. (A. 9504-D)
- ✓ \$100 million dedicated to both PAVE-NY and Bridge-NY to help fund our local infrastructure projects. (A.9504-D)
- ✓ \$37 million for the upkeep and support of mental health facilities. (A.9504-D)
- ✓ \$12 million for the protection of agriculture and farmland. (A.9504-D)

Issues not addressed in the 2018 Legislative Session that I will continue to fight for:

- ✗ Funding for a school resource officer in every school to keep our children safe.
- ✗ Ethics reform measures to address corruption in Albany, including term limits for committee leadership and campaign finance reform measures.
- ✗ Transparency or oversight of state economic development initiatives.
- ✗ Full repeal of SAFE Act.
