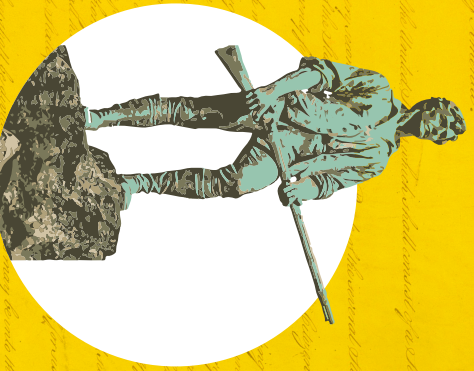

DAVID STOOD UP AGAINST NEW RESTRICTIVE LAWS TO:

- ▼ Give government licensing officers the sole authority to decide whether or not you are of "good moral character" to be allowed to exercise your Second Amendment right to carry a firearm.
- ▼ Force New Yorkers who have held pistol permits for decades to retake training courses, take a written test, and requalify on the range in order to keep their current license.
- ▼ Require a background/NICS check to purchase ammunition in New York State.
- ▼ Demand that any New Yorker who wishes to purchase a semiautomatic rifle to get a permit and register the firearm.

I'M INTRODUCING LEGISLATION TO:



Change the state definition of "Assault Weapon" to allow the use/sale of thumbhole stocks. (A.04198)



Permit concealed carry at state rest areas and scenic overlooks. (A.05229)



Authorize the carrying of firearms by military personnel at recruiting centers. (A.09919)

This legislative session, we have been leading the fight against the erosion of Second Amendment rights by **OPPOSING** bills to:

- ✘ Prevent gun owners from personalizing or changing the color of their firearm. (A.8736)
- ✘ Ban citizens from possessing unfinished receivers and parts. (A.8741)
- ✘ Outlaw home-builds and projects by anyone other than a licensed gunsmith. (A.8786)
- ✘ Prohibit the use of all lead rifle ammunition on state hunting land. (A.5728)
- ✘ Require all pistols sold in this state to be verified as microstamping-enabled. (A.7926)

NEED TO KNOW

Starting April 1, 2023, A.41001 makes it a crime to have a firearm in any of these "**sensitive locations**" or Gun-Free Zones:

- ⚠ Any place owned or under the control of the government that's used for administration
- ⚠ Any location providing health, behavioral health, or chemical dependence care or services
- ⚠ Any place of worship or religious observation
- ⚠ Public parks
- ⚠ Summer camps
- ⚠ Family shelters, domestic violence shelters, emergency shelters, and residential programs for victims of domestic violence
- ⚠ Any place or vehicle used for public transportation or public transit: subway cars, train cars, buses, ferries, railroad, omnibus, boat, or airplane; or any facility used for or in connection with service in the transportation of passengers, airports, train stations, subway and rail stations, and bus terminals
- ⚠ Any establishment issued a license for on-premise alcohol consumption (All bars and restaurants)
- ⚠ Any place used for performance, art entertainment, gaming, or sporting events: theaters, stadiums, racetracks, museums, amusement parks, performance venues, concerts, exhibits, conference centers, banquet halls, and gaming facilities
- ⚠ Any gathering of individuals to collectively express their constitutional rights to protest or assemble
