<u>SUBJECT</u>: Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act (CLCPA) Implementation

<u>PURPOSE</u>: To examine the progress of the CLCPA Implementation.

Chapter 106 of the Laws of 2019 established the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act (CLCPA), historic legislation that enacted sweeping requirements and goals to address climate change. The purpose of this hearing is to examine the implementation of the CLCPA, including the steps being taken by the Climate Action Council to develop the scoping plan, the Climate Justice Working Group's development of disadvantaged community definitions, and the progress of the State in achieving renewable energy goals.

Persons wishing to present pertinent testimony to the Committee at the above hearing should complete and return the enclosed reply form as soon as possible. It is important that the reply form be fully completed and returned so that persons may be notified of means by which to testify and/or in the event of emergency postponement or cancellation.

Oral testimony will be limited to ten minutes' duration. In preparing the order of witnesses, the Committee will attempt to accommodate individual requests to speak at particular times in view of special circumstances. These requests should be made on the attached reply form or communicated to Committee staff as early as possible.

Written testimony should be submitted via email two days prior to the hearing.

Attendees and participants at any legislative public hearing should be aware that these proceedings are video recorded. Their likenesses may be included in any video coverage shown on television or the internet.

In order to further publicize these hearings, please inform interested parties and organizations of the Committee's interest in hearing testimony from all sources.
