local government commodity procurement laws and the role of emerging

technology in achieving such goals

ORAL TESTIMONY WILL BE BY INVITATION ONLY

Each year, local governments across New York State spend billions of dollars to procure a wide variety of goods, from office supplies to life-saving emergency equipment. State laws governing municipal procurement generally require purchase contracts above \$20,000 to be competitively bid and awarded to the "lowest responsible bidder" or the bidder that represents the "best value" according to certain procurement criteria. As municipalities continue to navigate an evolving economic landscape, there have been calls for additional flexibility, transparency, and fairness throughout the procurement process, as well as questions concerning how technology may be better utilized to achieve these goals. The purpose of this hearing is to examine current state laws governing local government commodity procurement to determine what, if any, changes are needed to make the commodity procurement process more transparent, fair, and efficient, and what role, if any, emerging technology should play in these efforts.

Persons invited to present pertinent testimony to the Committees at the above hearing should complete and return the enclosed reply form as soon as possible. It is important that the reply form be fully completed and returned so that persons may be notified in the event of emergency postponement or cancellation.

Oral testimony will be limited to ten minutes' duration. In preparing the order of witnesses, the Committees will attempt to accommodate individual requests to speak at particular times in view of special circumstances. These requests should be made on the attached reply form or communicated to Committee staff as early as possible. Ten copies of any prepared testimony should be submitted at the hearing registration desk. The Committees would appreciate advance receipt of prepared statements.

Attendees and participants at any legislative public hearing should be aware that these proceedings are video recorded. Their likenesses may be included in any video coverage shown on television or the internet. In order to further publicize these hearings, please inform interested parties and organizations of the Committees' interest in hearing testimony from all sources.

In order to meet the needs of those who may have a disability, the Assembly, in accordance with its policy of non-discrimination on the basis of disability, as well as the 1990 Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), has made its facilities and services available to all individuals with disabilities.
